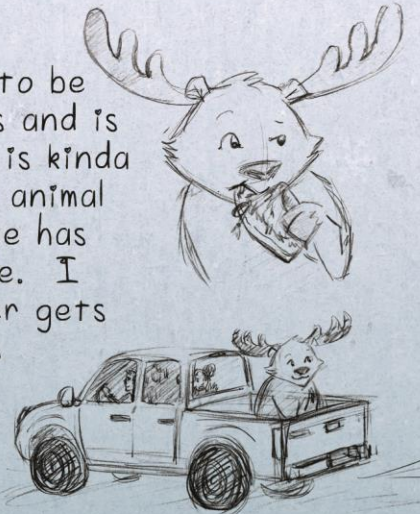
Alese
